The U.S. Department of Energy's Weatherization Assistance Program was created in 1976. October 30th has been declared Weatherization Day to focus on the Program's successes.

Here are some interesting Weatherization facts:

- Since the Program's inception, over 7.4 million homes have been weatherized.
- Occupants of weatherized homes save approximately \$250-\$450 annually on energy bills.
- For every \$1 invested, the Program returns \$4.10 to the household and community.
- Reduces the dependence on foreign oil and reduces carbon emissions.
- Weatherization impacts American workers and businesses, supporting at least 8,500 jobs and thousands more in related industries.
- Additional benefits more difficult to quantify include improved health and safety conditions and increased comfort for occupants.
